EMPLOYER’S RETIREMENT CONFIRMATION

Retirement Benefit is payable at age 65 years with no wage/earnings restriction; however, restrictions apply where the benefit is claimed early, i.e., from ages 60 to 64 years. This form seeks the employer’s verification that the claimant has stopped working or is not substantially employed. It is to be signed by the employer or the employer’s representative and must accompany claims for retirement benefit by persons younger than 65 years.

Any person who, for the purpose of obtaining benefit under the National Insurance Act, knowingly makes any false statement or false representations or produces any document, etc. which he/she knows to be false, shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500), or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding twelve (12) months or both.
