RESIGNATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF NIB

Mr. Troy Smith, Chairman of the National Insurance Board wishes to advise that Dr. Nicola Virgill-Rolle, has tendered her resignation as Director/CEO of NIB. Since appointed Director in July 2018, Dr. Rolle has led the management team and the organisation through two significant periods in its history, namely the impact of Hurricane Dorian in September 2019 and more recently, the COVID-19 pandemic. The Board extends its gratitude to Dr. Rolle for the contribution she has made to NIB during her tenure.

The Chairman also assures stakeholders that the structure and mechanisms within the Board are well established to ensure continued operations. An announcement on the appointment of a new Director will be made at a later date by the Ministry of the Public Service and National Insurance.
